### [EUNEC conference on transitions between education and the labour market](#)

On 20-21 October, EUNEC organized its conference on 'Bridging the transitions between education and the labour market'. The event was hosted by CZESHA, the Unions of Schools' Associations of the Czech Republic.

More than 40 participants from 14 European countries participated at the event: stakeholders, policy makers and experts in the field of vocational education and training. Key note speakers were performed by OECD and CEDEFOP; a panorama of good practices was presented by Romania, Germany, Belgium, Ireland and the Czech Republic.
